Off Licence Renewal

Sections 17 to 20, and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

Pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 (the **Act**), **AMATIS LIMITED** (the licensee) is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at **270 MATAHUI ROAD**, **KATIKATI** and known as **MATAHUI DISTILLERY**, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free, as a sample, for consumption on the premises. The licensee is also authorised to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

1. Alcohol, subject to condition 3, may be sold on and delivered from the premises for consumption off the premises, or supplied free as a sample for consumption on the premises, only on the following days and hours:

Monday to Sunday 7:00 am to 9:00 pm

- 2. No alcohol is to be delivered from the premises on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, or Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day.
- 3. A remote sale of alcohol may be made at any time on any day. Any alcohol sold by remote sale must not be delivered at any time after 11 pm on any day and before 6 am on the next day.
- 4. The on-site sale of alcohol is restricted to those alcoholic products manufactured on the property.
- 5. For remote sale the licensee must comply with the requirements set out in Regulations 14 & 15 of the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Regulations 2013 to ensure neither the purchaser not the person to whom alcohol is delivered is a minor.
- 6. While alcohol is being provided free as a sample, water is to be provided to patrons free of charge at the place where the samples are being supplied.
- 7. A properly appointed certificated or acting or temporary manager must be on duty at all times, within the licensed area, when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, and their full name must be on a sign prominently displayed in the premises.
- 8. The licensee must display at the premises:
 - a. At every point of sale, signs detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;
 - b. At the principal entrance to the premises, so as to be easily read by people outside the premises, a sign stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of alcohol;
 - c. A copy of the licence attached to the inside of the premises so as to be easily read by people entering each principal entrance.

The premises are set out on the plan submitted with the application and date stamped 17 April 2024. A note to this effect is to be made on the licence.

The licence is renewed for three (3) years from the expiry date of the current licence and a replacement licence is to be issued.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it was last renewed; or
- (b) if an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire, until the close of the period of 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

This licence replaces licence no. 022/OFF/8862/2023 and this licence continues in force until 03 May 2027 unless again renewed.
